

Student Immunization Reminder

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, families are reminded that Iowa Code [139A.8](#) requires students to have required immunizations, an approved Certificate of Immunization Exemption, or a Provisional Certificate of Immunization on file with the school before attending school.

Students entering certain grade levels may have additional immunization requirements. Families should review their child's records and submit updated documentation to the school nurse as soon as possible to ensure all requirements are met before the first day of school.

Families who choose not to provide a Certificate of Immunization may submit a valid Medical or Religious Exemption Certificate as allowed under Iowa law. Information regarding exemption requirements and the process for obtaining a valid exemption is available through the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services at <https://hhs.iowa.gov/health-prevention/vaccines-immunizations>.
