

Special Meeting  
January 4, 2023

The Board of Directors of the Louisa-Muscatine CSD met in special session on Wednesday, January 4, 2023 beginning at 4:00 p.m. Board members present included Scott Wilson, Carol Whittaker, Bryce Hoben and Jeff Riggan. Barbara Thompson was absent. Also present was Supt. Mike Van Sickle.

Call to Order/Approval of the Agenda

President Wilson called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Hoben moved and Whittaker seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Presentation of Survey Results

Darin Sievers, Project Manager for School Perceptions presented their survey results for the potential bonding referendum. He noted the survey went out to every mailbox. Mr. Sievers stated that they received 378 responses to the survey, which calculates to a 15.1% response rate and a margin of error % of 5.14. He stated the overall weighted support for the referendum was only 45.75% in favor. Mr. Sievers showed survey results that the district was in the 83<sup>rd</sup> percentile on recommending the district, 69<sup>th</sup> percentile for delivering a high-quality education and 75<sup>th</sup> percentile in managing its funds appropriately. Mr. Sievers stated the referendum would likely not be supported today, but felt the district was highly regarded and parents were very supportive.

Adjournment

Whittaker moved and Hoben seconded to adjourn the meeting at 5:06 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.
